

Diabetes and Insulin Pump Therapy (Continuous Subcutaneous Insulin Infusion)

5. The emotional impact around the change from multiple daily injections (MDI) to CSII.
6. The role of continuous blood glucose measurement, and the interpretation and utilization of results in practice.
7. The impact of insulin pump therapy for different specialty areas.
8. The implementation and running of an insulin pump service.

This interactive online course will be delivered over a five-week period, using innovative technologies to give you the flexibility to study at any time, in a place that suits you. You will also be offered the opportunity to personally experience wearing and using CSII current technology.
